

Disclosure of Amendments to the Code of Business Ethics and Conduct

On March 25, 2026, the Board of Directors of Invivyd, Inc. (the “Company”) approved amendments to the Company’s Code of Business Ethics and Conduct (the “Code”) that (i) updated certain provisions, including those related to anti-bribery and anti-corruption, fair competition, insider trading prevention, interactions with healthcare professionals, doing business with third parties, conflicts of interest, gifts, privacy, information protection, technology, including artificial intelligence, company records, public disclosures, workplace environment, and colleague interactions and conduct; (ii) expanded on topics related to patients, science, and quality; and (iii) clarified Code governance and administration. The updated Code maintains essential principles and standards contained in the prior Code. Other changes to the Code included changes of a technical, administrative and non-substantive nature. This summary of amendments to the Code is qualified in its entirety by reference to the full text of the updated Code.
